In their little hut on the outskirts of Chicago, these two brothers secretly opened an Irish Public House where patrons could get a quick swig of a tasty ale or spirit. Because their place became so popular, they shortened the name to

The Pub so they would not be discovered. They were trendsetters for their time and served their patrons into the wee hours of the morning. Seamus and Finn became legends and masters of their craft.

When Prohibition ended, they opened DaddyO's Pub and their legacy lives on today.

Craft Bottles

Goose Island, Chicago, Ill

Honker's Ale, English Style Ale – IPA 4.2% ABV 6.5
Golden sunset in color, with tiny sediment in suspension, mild carbonation and a creamy ivory cap with good retention. A swirl brings out light, herbal, hoppy aromas. Slightly fruity taste with peppery hops up front, followed by light buttery, caramel malt with mild bitterness on the end. A very nicely balanced beer by a Chicago brewer.

312, Urban Wheat Ale 4.2% ABV 6.5
Cloudy yellow in color and densely populated with flavor, 312's spicy aroma of Cascade hops is followed by a crisp, fruity ale flavor delivered in a smooth, creamy body.

Metropolitan, Chicago, Ill

Krankshaft Lager, 5% ABV 6.5
Very pale yellowish color with a small, foamy head. Subtle citrus hops and a bit of nutty malt in the nose. Slightly tart and delicately flavored. Mouth feel is crisp with full carbonation. Finishes with a mild, earthy bitterness. Great example of a Kolsch style lager by a relatively new Chicago brewer.

Two Brothers, Warrenville, IL

Domaine DuPage – Red Ale 5.9% ABV 6.5
Domaine DuPage is a rural, northern France, amber colored ale. This well balanced beer is full and sweet up front with caramel, toasty, and fruity characters. The finish has a gentle floral and spicy hop balance that cleanses the palate.

Barley Island, Noblesville, IN

Dirty Helen – Brown Ale 4.3% ABV 6.5
Dirty Helen, legendary Milwaukee tavern owner born in Noblesville, in addition to being Al Capon's "favorite girl," supposedly could out-swear anybody in town. This Brown Ale has a penny copper color. It has a rich malty flavor with hints of chocolate and slightly nutty finish.

Craft Bottles

Great Lakes Brewing Co,

Cleveland, OH

Eliot Ness - Amber Lager, 6.2% ABV 6.5
Named after the man who helped bring down Al Capone. An amber lager with rich, fragrant malt flavors balanced by crisp, noble hops. Gold Medal winner at 5 of the last 6 World Beer Championships.

Brooklyn, New York, NY

Lager 5.2% ABV 6.5
Flagship of the brewery and award-winning lager is amber-gold in color, and displays a firm malt center supported by a fine bitterness and floral hop aroma. Caramel malts show in the finish. The aromatic qualities of the beer are enhanced by "dry-hopping," the centuries-old practice of steeping the beer with fresh hops as it undergoes a long, cold maturation. The result is a wonderfully flavorful beer, smooth, refreshing and very versatile with food.

Sierra Nevada, Chico, CA

Torpedo – Extra IPA 7.5% ABV 6.5
Sierra Nevada Torpedo Ale is a big American IPA; bold, assertive and full of flavor and aromas highlighting the complex citrus, pine and herbal character of whole-cone American hops.

New Belgium, Fort Collins, CO

Fat Tire Amber Ale 22oz 5.3% ABV 8.0
Toasty, biscuity maltiness so pleasantly balanced with a crisp hops finish.

1554 – Belgian Dark Ale 5.6% ABV 6.5
Brussels-style Black Ale based on a 16th century recipe brewed w/lager yeast at a warm temperatures for an easy-drinking full malt flavor.

Draft Beers

Green Line, Chicago, Ill 6.5

Pale Ale 5.0% ABV

A honey-colored, immensely sessionable, environmentally friendly, American pale ale with a pronounced, bright, American hop aroma and citrus flavor. Notes of biscuit and lightly toasted malt create the backbone for Green Line's pleasant, crisp bitterness.

Guinness, St. James Gate/Dublin, Ireland 6.5

Stout 4.2% ABV

Swirling clouds tumble as the storm begins to calm, settle, breathe in the moment, then break through the smooth, light head to the bittersweet reward. Best at 42.8F with the legendary two-part pour, which takes about 119 seconds, but is well worth the wait.

Harp, Dundalk, County Louth, Ireland 6.5

Lager 4.3% ABV

Best known for its half of "Half and Halfs" with Guinness, Harp is bright golden in color. It has a fruity nose with a crisp, clean, slightly bitter upfront taste that ends with a smooth aftertaste.

Miller Lite, Milwaukee, WI 6.5

American Style Light Lager 4.2% ABV

America is the birthplace of light beer. Introduced in 1975 by Miller, light lagers have become the best-selling beers in the US.

Smithwick's, Dundalk, Ireland 6.5

Irish Red Ale 5% ABV

Ireland's Oldest Ale, since 1710, has a creamy head, a palate that is very soft at first but develops in sweetness, and a hint of treacle toffee dryness in the finish. It is brewed from Pale Ale malt, roasted barley and 20 per cent corn syrup, with English bittering hops, plus Fuggles and Goldings for aroma. Smithwick's had used the same yeast for years, and the beer has a week's cold maturation.
