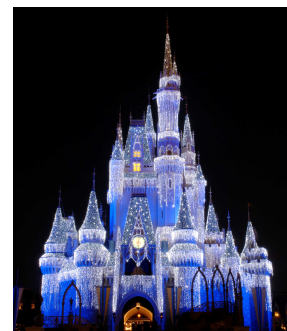


Winter Fantasy: November 21-December 13 Holidays at Disneyland: November 20-December 13

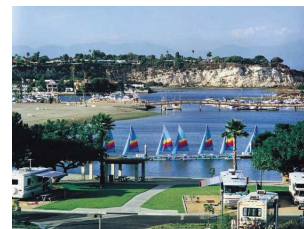


Corona Del Mar Christmas Walk: December 6 Lighting of the Bay: December 4
