#### **Sterling, Chardonnay, "Reserve", Napa Valley, 2005, California**

Bold flavors of pear and Golden Delicious apple with hints of pineapple, baking spices and vanilla are evident before giving way to a creamy mouth feel eventually leading to a supple, tropical finish

#### **Cakebread Cellars, Chardonnay, Napa Valley, 2006, California**

Lovely ripe pear and sweet citrus aromas lifted by fragrant white flower and subtle toasty oak scents. On the palate a sleek entry expands into a creamy concentrated mid-palate with rich lemon zest, melon, white peach and vanilla flavors segueing seamlessly into a refreshing flinty mineral-tinged finish

### Full Intensity Red Wines

Listed from milder to strongest

#### **Nickel & Nickel, Cabernet Sauvignon, "Tench Vineyard", Oakville, 2004, California**

The palate on this Cabernet is filled with flavors of blueberries and boysenberries, layered with bay leaf and spice; the sweet toasty flavors from the French oak integrates with the fruit to create a rich, supple texture that carries a long finish

#### **Dominus, Cabernet Blend, Napa Valley, 2004 California**

This exhibits a big sweet, cedary, roasted herb mocha, black cherry liqueur, black currant, and earth-scented perfume; medium to full-bodied with silky tannin as well as a luscious mouth feel and finish

#### **Jordan, Cabernet Sauvignon, Alexander Valley, 2003, California**

The blending of Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot with the Cabernet Sauvignon is responsible for the well integrated flavors, deep color and full mouth feel, a restrained framework of oak and a lingering finish of subtle earth, cigar, tobacco and cedar

#### **Stags' Leap Winery, Cabernet Sauvignon, "The Leap", Napa Valley, 2002 California**

The flavors are mature and expressive rather than jammy; the nose shows elegant dried herb aromatics, leading into ripe flavors of blackberry, plum and cassis with notes of rhubarb, black pepper and licorice; a structure of finely grained tannin is the last major component, binding the ripe mature flavors together

#### **Rubicon Estate, Cabernet Sauvignon, "Cask", Rutherford, 2003, California**

Layers of ripe red cherries, plum vanilla, cocoa and toast; the flavor is intense but with a pleasing, supple mouth feel

#### **Opus One, Cabernet Blend, Napa Valley, 2003, California**

A moderately deep garnet of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Petit Verdot, this Napa Valley "red wine" offers aromas of blackberry, plum, hazelnut, graphite, olive oil, cocoa and dried cherries; this wine presents a soft rich entry with nuances of dark chocolate, black licorice and herbs linger on the finish
