



## Recreational Group Activities

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### 5K FUN RUN/WALK

***Run or walk through the scenic areas of the resort. Participants may be divided into categories. This will take place on jogging trail “C” and includes staffing, official numbers and scoring and a pace vehicle.***

### Pitch ‘n Putt or Nite Lite Tournaments

***Day or evening tournaments are available on this 9-hole executive course. The course will be closed for your group during your event. Contests such as Longest Putt and Closest to the Pin may also be arranged. Also included are greens fees, tournament fees, golf clubs and balls, pairing and scoring.***

### NATURE WALK

***Our Resort along with the Audubon Society has preserved this 45-acre cypress swamp so our guests can see and experience an important part of Florida’s natural heritage. The walk is a one-mile boardwalk that will allow you to explore the sights and sounds of Florida’s wildlife. Guide included. We can also have a Nature Specialist bring out some wildlife including a Bald Eagle or an Alligator. (Price may vary)***

# Maritime Mania

*The Challenge: Design and build a 2-person powered corrugated cardboard boat capable of racing the designated course. Each team will be given cardboard, duct tape and foam to create a boat that holds 2! Each team will name and decorate their boat, designate a Captain and First Mate, introduce their creation, and participate in the boat parade. Each team will have one hour to design and decorate their boats.*

*All necessary equipment and supplies will be provided for the construction and decoration of the boats. Motivational music is also provided. You may not use any other items to build your boat except the ones that are given to each team.*

*The boat parade will take place on the beach and upper pool deck, followed by the races in the pool.*

## SUPERSPORTS/TEAM BUILDING

*This event is designed to enhance team unity and encourage friendly competition with the entire group. Supersports is tailored for your group to have a wild time as well as show off their athletic abilities. Each package for the Supersports will include the following:*

- *The opening ceremony with team and staff introductions and instructions for team cheer.*
- *Amplified sound system with music during the events*
- *Official Master of Ceremonies and Command Center*
- *Referees and certified CPR and First Aid trained hotel staff*
- *Your choice of events and a great time!*

*The recommended format is 2-3 hours, 5-6 events and no more than 10 teams.*

*Choice of events:*

### **Boardwalk**

*All team members participate in this event. Each team stands on two 12' pieces of wood while holding onto ropes that are attached to the boards. At the signal to begin, they must attempt to walk the boards from start to finish.*

### Canoe Relay

*Each team has fifteen minutes to see how many canoes they can paddle out to the buoy and back.*

### Water Balloon/Egg Toss

*One team member passes the egg/water balloon to their teammate, moving back one foot every successful time without breaking it. Team with the most remaining wins.*

### Crazy Event

*This event has four stations or corners and is a timed relay event in teams of five. To begin, one team member from each team runs through some tires and to the first station. Here, using just their mouths, they bury their faces deep into a pie tin filled with whipped cream to retrieve a single strawberry. They then run to the second station where they are to put on a uniform, then run to the third station where they pick up a baseball bat and placing the handle to their heads (with the base on the ground), participants spin around three times. They then run to the finish line. This is repeated until all five team members have completed the event.*

### Volleyball

*All team members participate. Must be serving to score a point. First team to the highest score or to fifteen at the end of the time limit wins. Event played on a grass court.*

### Egg-Drop

*All teammates participate. Each team is given one (1) egg, twenty (20) straws, twenty (20) inches of tape, and two (2) balloons. You must construct a device that will surround the egg so that when it is dropped from a height of eight (8) feet it will not break.*

### Balloon Drop

*All team members participate to carry as many water balloons as possible between their knees and drop them into a crate opposite the starting line without breaking any balloons.*

### Flour Pass

*All team members participate. Team lines up sitting one behind the other, scooping flour out of a bucket, passing the flour directly over their heads. The team that transfers the most flour to the cup wins.*

### Dizzy Izzy

*All team members participate. They run to a baseball bat 20 yards away. Placing their forehead on the bat, they spin around six times, they then run back and touch the hand of the next team member. This is a relay.*

### Cheese Face

*All team members participate. All team captains will get their faces covered with shaving cream. Each member will have a hand full of cheese puffs. They throw the cheese puffs at the captain's face trying to get them to stick. The team with the most cheese puffs sticking wins.*

Pie Eating Contest

*Only captains participate. Whoever eats their pie first wins.*

Tug-o-War

*Two teams will pull a rope against each other. When the ribbon goes over a certain point, a team wins.*

Wordles

*Each team will get a list of 75 wordles. An example of a wordle is:*

MAN  
BOARD  
(Answer: Man Overboard)

Basketball Hot Shots

*Each participant has one minute to shoot as many baskets as possible from behind a line. Team with the most total baskets wins.*

Team Cheer

*Each team will have 10 minutes to plan a cheer. After 10 minutes, all teams will assemble to the center stage where they will perform in front of the judges.*

Vegetable Race Cars

*Teams are provided with fresh produce and the necessary supplies to construct racing vehicles. We will then send them down a track to see whose team builds the best vehicle.*

Sandcastle Sculpture Contest

*Four or more people per team. Participants are judged on creativity.*

Drink Relay

*Cups full of any drink are located 25 yards away. Each team member must run out to the cup, down the beverage and return and tag the next team member. (beer, lemonade, water, etc).*

Flying Frisbee

*Have player's line up with a Frisbee. Additional players line up behind them. Have players try to land Frisbee's in designated rings for points, accuracy, and distance. Have each player retrieve their Frisbee's and hand them of to the next player in line.*

Coke Bottle Relay

*Each team member lines up directly behind each other. The first team member is handed a coke bottle with some water in it. He/she passes the coke bottle over his/her head with a finger blocking the opening of the bottle. The team with the most water left in the bottle wins.*

### Fitness Fanatic

*Two members run twenty yards with a baton and pass off to their teammate who is located in a designated circle. The teammate must then perform ten sit-ups. The baton is then passed off to another teammate who runs back down twenty yards, hands off the baton to two members on a Quadricycle bike who must cycle past the finish line. This event is timed.*

### Swimming Relay

*Perform a variety of strokes across the lagoon pool.*

### Pitch-N-Putt

*A shoot out on one hole.*

### Ping Pong Drink Toss

*The object is to try and bounce your Ping-Pong balls into your opponent's cups, where they in turn have to drink the entire cup. The team with the most full cups at the end of the time limit wins. (Any beverage can be used).*

### Topsy-Turvy

*Teams must stand on and turn over a tarp without anyone stepping off the tarp and touching the ground. This event is scored by the amount of time it takes for each team to complete the task.*

### Balloon Building

*Each team will be challenged to build the tallest freestanding tower using balloons and tape. We will measure the height of each tower and award points from the tallest down.*

### Blindfolded Bluff

*Each Team will select two (2) members to navigate a "field", collecting the designated loot, with the help of the remaining team. The two (2) members are blindfolded and the remaining members must verbally guide them through the course. Loss of loot results in touching the obstacles.*

## **BASKETBALL 3 ON 3 COMPETITIONS**

*A tournament can be arranged with referees for a 3 on 3 competition (half court. It would need to be determined how many people per team and if they are allowed a sub or not. The refs will call all fouls and traveling. There will be scorers at each court.*

## TENNIS TOURNAMENT

*All of the tennis tournaments are handled through Lynn Bottger, the Director of our Tennis facility. Her number is 407/239-4470. She can help with any tournaments or round robins, or any type of tennis arrangements needed.*

## VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT

*The Recreation Staff can engage your attendees in some friendly competition! Single elimination tournaments are available in the pool, on grass or sand.*

## Rock Climbing Wall

*Be the first to climb to the top of our 24 foot Rock Wall! The wall has 4 different skill levels and is located on the upper Pool Deck. The wall may be rented exclusively for your group during a reception or for an afternoon team-building event.*

## Children's Programs

*These programs are planned exclusively for your group and are separate from Child Care or our daily Camp Hyatt Services. They are designed to coordinate with the meeting or reception schedule of the attendees. These programs are for ages 4-12 and the children must be out of diapers and pull ups. The campers will participate in a variety of activities including local arts and crafts, team games, talent shows, sports, scavenger hunts and much more! Our staffing ratio is one counselor to every 4 children. Teen programs are available on request.*

*This is the perfect way to reward your top performers! Group accommodations may be made for massage service and we have some of the most experienced therapists in the area. Chair massages are also available.*

# Pricing

5K Fun Run/Walk: \$20.00 per person with a \$300.00 minimum charge and a 22% service charge.

Pitch N' Putt Tournaments: \$25 per person during the day and \$45 per person for Nite Lite. A 22% service charge applies. Professional golf instructor \$200. Minimum of 20 players.

Nature Walk: \$15.00 per person with a minimum charge of \$200.00. A 22% service charge applies. Additional charge for Nature Specialist.

Maritime Mania: \$400.00 per team with a minimum of 5 teams. A 22% service charge applies.

Supersports: \$45 per person with a minimum of 40 participants. A 22% service charge applies. Some events may require an additional charge.

Rock Climbing Wall: \$200.00 per hour for an unlimited amount of climbers and 2 staff members. A 22% service charge also applies.

Basketball or Volleyball Tournaments: \$150.00 per team with a minimum of 6 teams. A 22% service charge applies. To reserve only is \$50 per court per hour.

Children's Programs: The rates for these programs will vary depending on the number of children and the length of each session. There is a 22% service charge added to each session. Meals must be planned as a banquet and will be priced separately.

Group Massage Appointments: Relaxation, Therapeutic and Aromatherapy are available for 60-minute sessions. Pricing ranges from \$105-\$115. A 22% service charge applies to each session. Please note that some appointments may take place in converted suites.
