Overview

Surrounded by a stunning house reef in the scenic Raa Atoll, the resort offers serenity and discovery in an awe-inspiring destination embraced by nature's wonders.

- The natural island resort was built in thick jungle vegetation, and care was taken to avoid the cutting down of trees and shrubs where possible
- Architecture blends in perfectly with the surroundings
- The house reef is strengthened by replanting coral fragments grown in a coral nursery

Carbon Emissions and Water

- A solar power system is used to produce electricity to reduce fuel burn from generators
- Laundry operating hours during the day to maximise use of solar energy
- Our daily operational reports such as Eco Track are used to effectively monitor and reduce waste
- Sewage is recycled using an SBR system to create reusable water for our garden
- Through our Conserve program, we change linen every third day unless requested otherwise, and guests may choose to reuse towels by leaving them hanging
- Coral fragments are grown in a coral nursery

Waste and Circularity

Alila Kothaifaru is committed to reducing waste going to the landfill to zero by using a glass crusher, compactor, incinerator, organic shredder and food composter to produce fertiliser.

- Single-use plastic is reduced to a minimum
- Purified drinking water is produced in-house by a reverse osmosis system and bottled in reusable glass bottles
- All room amenities are placed in large refill bottles

Our Food Philosophy

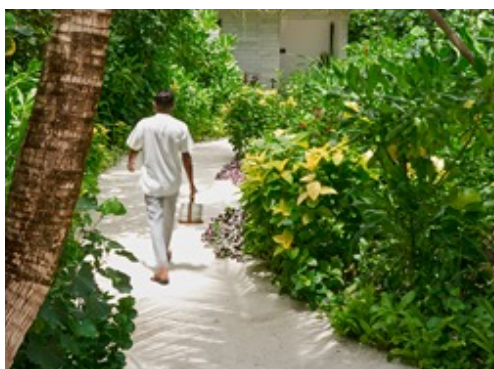
Hyatt's 'Food. Thoughtfully Sourced. Carefully Served.' philosophy guides us in how we select ingredients that are better for people, communities and the planet.

- Seafood is sustainably purchased from responsible local sources
- As much as we possibly can, produce is organic and purchased locally or regionally
- Plant-based and plant-forward menu items are offered in our all restaurants and bars
- By offering à la carte menus we reduce the amount of pre-cooked food. The breakfast buffet is a semi buffet with main dishes served à la carte
- Following the new Maldives General Fisheries Regulation, parrotfish are not featured on our menus.

- We are committed to complying with relevant regulations and permits, and working on the continued improvement of our environmental performance

- We produce and provide purified drinking water to all guests and associates at the resort. This water is produced in-house and bottled in reusable glass bottles
- We offer our guests and associates the opportunity to participate in our sustainability activities, constantly creating Alila journeys in support of this policy. The commitment is to continue improving our sustainability initiatives, energy efficiency and benchmarking as part of our goals
- Alila Kothaifaru Maldives strives to advance the responsible sourcing of products and services associated with concerns for climate change, deforestation, human rights, waste, public health, resources scarcity, biodiversity and animal welfare
- We are committed to building a strong relationship and collaboration with the local community. We prioritise the purchase of fresh local products from local suppliers

- We measure sustainability metrics using Hyatt Eco Track to monitor environmental performance. We are additionally committed to providing accurate environmental statements to our stakeholders
