The Heart of Kuala Lumpur: Inspired by the River Confluence

The "River of Life" celebrates Kuala Lumpur's origins—its name derives from the meeting point of the Gombak and Klang Rivers, marking the city's birthplace. This natural confluence symbolizes unity and growth.

With the acquisition of Wisma KFC (now Hyatt Centric City Centre Kuala Lumpur) drew inspiration from this iconic river meeting. The building's façade features embossed stainless panels with water ripple patterns, reflecting the shimmering flow of the rivers. This design embodies Kuala Lumpur's rich heritage and modern spirit, positioning the hotel as the merging point of Hap Seng's journey with the city's vibrant skyline.



An Entrance Like No Other: Inspired by KL's River Confluence

Inspired by Kuala Lumpur's iconic Gombak and Klang rivers, the Arrival Experience features a stunning fountain with gushing water, colorful lights, and mist to welcome guests into the city's heart. Overhead, a dramatic red steel-framed canopy and a shimmering stainless-steel wave sculpture create a warm, dynamic entrance. This vibrant display of sounds, mist, and flowing lights connects guests to the city's energy the moment they arrive.

When you're in Kuala Lumpur, make sure to visit the River of Life. Stroll along its beautifully illuminated promenade, admire the dynamic fountains, and experience a space where the city's history and contemporary energy converge—just like the spirit of Hyatt Centric City Centre KL itself.



Inspired by Nature: The Bukit Nanas Forest Trail

Our indoor spiral staircase is inspired by the lush forest trails of Bukit Nanas, particularly resembling the scenic staircase at KL Forest Eco Park. It echoes the natural beauty of this iconic hill, blending serenity with innovative design.

Once known as Weld Hill during colonial times, Bukit Nanas is Kuala Lumpur's only remaining virgin tropical rainforest, standing 94 meters above sea level. The Bukit Nanas Forest Reserve offers jungle trails, a visitor centre, and a forestry museum. The KL Tower and other landmarks are also located here.

This design element brings the lush, calming atmosphere of Bukit Nanas into our space, creating a connection to nature right within the hotel.

Visit KL Forest Eco Park—just a 10-minute walk from our hotel. Alternatively, hop on the Hop-On Hop-Off bus for a convenient and scenic route to explore this urban rainforest and its surrounding landmarks.



让吉隆坡鲜活起来

吉隆坡的心脏：源于河流汇聚的灵感

“生命之河”（River of Life）象征吉隆坡的起源——城市名称源自鹅唛河与巴生河的交汇处，这里也是吉隆坡的诞生地。河流的汇聚寓意团结与成长。

在收购肯德基总部（Wisma KFC）现为吉隆坡凯悦尚萃市中后，建筑设计从这一标志性河流交汇汲取灵感。立面采用浮雕不锈钢面板，呈现水波纹理，映照河水的流动光影。此设计既彰显吉隆坡丰厚的历史底蕴，也融入现代都市精神，使酒店成为合成统一（Hap Seng）发展历程与城市活力天际线交汇的独特节点。



独一无二的入口：源自吉隆坡河流汇聚

入口设计以吉隆坡标志性的鹅唛河与巴生河为灵感，打造了令人惊叹的迎宾体验：喷泉激起的水花、色彩斑斓的灯光与薄雾相互映衬，为宾客呈现城市的心脏地带。头顶的红色钢架遮棚与闪亮的不锈钢波浪雕塑相得益彰，营造出温暖而充满活力的入口氛围。声音、雾气与流动灯光的多重体验，让宾客一踏入酒店便感受到吉隆坡的城市能量。

来到吉隆坡时，也不要错过“生命之河”（River of Life）。沿着灯光璀璨的河滨漫步，欣赏动态喷泉，在历史与现代能量交汇的空间中感受城市的活力——正如吉隆坡凯悦尚萃市中心所体现的精神。



自然启发：武吉奈纳斯山生态公园

酒店的室内螺旋楼梯灵感源自奈纳斯山 (Bukit Nanas) 茂密的森林步道，尤其参考了吉隆坡森林生态公园 (KL Forest Eco Park) 的景观楼梯，巧妙融合自然美景与创新设计，营造宁静而富有灵感的空间氛围。

武吉奈纳斯山在殖民时期曾被称为 Weld Hill，是吉隆坡唯一保存完好的原始热带雨林，海拔约94米。这里设有森林保护区、丛林步道、游客中心及林业博物馆，同时也是吉隆坡塔及其他地标的所在地。
