Hyatt Regency Lost Pines Resort & Spa Announces MEET The Great Outdoors Program

Austin, Texas (January 28, 2021) – Hyatt Regency Lost Pines Resort & Spa, located on 405 acres of Texas landscape right outside of Austin and near the city of Bastrop, announces the MEET The Great Outdoors experience for groups. The program showcases the resort’s open-air venues and outdoor activities, while providing a special promotion for 2021 meetings and events.

“As planners continue to seek outdoor destinations for 2021 meetings, we are thrilled to present the MEET The Great Outdoors program,” said Cory Baum, director of sales and marketing at Hyatt Regency Lost Pines Resort & Spa. “At Lost Pines, groups can safely meet while enjoying an unforgettable Texas getaway. We provide a plethora of gorgeous outdoor spaces with everything from a natural amphitheater overlooking the river to pavilions with retractable glass walls. We also offer a robust menu of unforgettable outdoor experiences, from horseback rides and archery to trap shooting classes and ziplining excursions.”

Throughout 2021, the resort is providing a special promotion for outdoor events. Functions with 10 to 150 peak room nights will receive a complimentary one-hour private s’mores roast, a 50 percent discount on outdoor setup fees, a 20 percent discount on outdoor lighting, complimentary standard wi-fi in meeting space, and complimentary self-parking for attendees. Meetings with 151 peak room nights or more will also receive a 50 percent allowable attrition slippage rate for added flexibility. The promotion is available for outdoor meetings booked and held before December 31, 2021. Planners must reference the offer code “OUTDOORS” when scheduling their event.

Hyatt Regency Lost Pines Resort & Spa is home to 240,000 square feet of outdoor event space. It features the recently-renovated LBJ Pavilion, a 6,000 square foot pavilion outfitted with floor-to-ceiling retractable glass walls to provide indoor/outdoor functionality year-round. The pavilion is connected to a spacious adjoining deck and the Riverside Amphitheater, a natural grassy hillside that overlooks the Colorado River and serves as auditorium seating for a speaker or performance.

Additional outdoor options include the 12,500 square foot Riversong Lawn, a sprawling turf lawn backdropped by the resort’s back porch to reflect the look and feel of a classic Texas Ranch reception; the Pecan Terrace and Pecan Court, both located in the resort’s “Pecan Grove” surrounded by its towering namesake trees; the Wildflower Pavilion, which is connected to the golf club house and provides floor-to-ceiling retractable glass walls for indoor/outdoor use; and several options on Wolfdancer golf course including the “Top of the World” 12th hole, which is the highest elevation point in Bastrop County delivering sweeping views of the region.

The resort’s outdoor meeting venues are complemented by 60,000 square-feet of indoor space including the 15,913 square foot Lost Pines Ballroom; the 7,616 square-foot Baron’s Ballroom; and 18 additional boardrooms, parlors, and breakout rooms in its Leatherstocking and Colonists Hall.

Hyatt Regency Lost Pines also provides unforgettable experiences for groups to explore the Texas outdoors. Attendees can enjoy horseback trail rides through the loblolly forest, archery classes, or expert-led shotgun trap shoot experiences at the on-site Renegade Trailhead. Planners can also arrange fishing excursions to the resort's pond stocked with bass, carp, and catfish, or coordinate tournaments or scrambles at the award-winning Wolfdancer Golf Club. True to its Central Texas location, the resort also offers breakout sessions with its friendly animal mascots including two Texas longhorn steers, two alpacas, and miniature goats named after iconic Country music artists Waylon, Willie, Johnny, and Hank.

In addition to the available on-site activities, groups have direct access to a plethora of experiences at the adjoining 1,140-acre McKinney Roughs Nature Park. Planners can select from zip-lining adventures, adrenaline-inducing UTV tours, or rejuvenating hikes on an 18-mile nature trail system.
