At Hyatt Regency Hong Kong, Tsim Sha Tsui, we recognize the potential negative impacts our activities may have on the environment and community, if not properly managed. Hence, we are committed to advancing sustainability actions so that our destination and communities remain vibrant and resilient.

We are committed to continual improvement with active measurement of metrics such as energy, water consumption and waste generation through an internal tracking platform – EcoTrack, and a partnership with EarthCheck, the world’s leading scientific benchmarking certification and advisory group for travel and tourism.

The EarthCheck programme requires reporting our performance to benchmark our hotel against regional average and leaders in the hotel sector. The programme is built on a continual improvement model and will aid us in achieving best practices in our operations. We have appointed the Engineering Manager as our EarthCheck Coordinator, and along with our Green Committee, they will be responsible for reviewing and improving the hotel’s sustainable performance.

In addition, World of Care, our corporate Environmental, Social, Governance (ESG) framework, guides our focus areas and goals. Defined by understanding what is important to our colleagues, guests, customers, owners and communities, our ongoing engagement with these stakeholders and our broader supply chain enables us to continue to evolve our strategy to address emerging needs.
