Before opening its doors to the public, the Chicago Athletic Association was a private club for decades. The Venetian-inspired property (designed to resemble the Doge's Palace in Venice) has since been reborn as a luxury hotel that welcomes guests with a collection of arched windows, restored fireplaces, custom-furnished rooms, and a 24-hour fitness center. Located on Michigan Avenue just across from Millennium Park and originally built for the World's Columbian Exposition, it's a convenient choice for visitors in town for concerts and festivals. This hotel is also located within walking distance of the Art Institute of Chicago and Quartino's, one of the best Italian restaurants in Chicago.
